Gerontology Days 12 (Hungarian) - 13 (English - online) October 2023

The Gerontology Days 2023 International Scientific Conference was organised by the Faculty of Health Sciences in mid-October.

Day 0 featured the book launch of the Positive Ageing Book 1, which we reported on earlier. During this programme, participants could also enjoy a performance by the Sósperec orchestra and the wines of the Istenhegyi winery in the Tokaj valley.

The first day of the conference brought together gerontologists, researchers, educators and practitioners at the Nyíregyháza Campus. Traditionally, this day is also an accredited scoreboard for social workers.

We will prepare the accreditation material and invite speakers in the spring, so that we can offer a good opportunity for high-level knowledge sharing and scoring," said Mónika Kótisné Plajner, the Faculty's administrator for Social Continuing Education.

The Conference was opened by Dean Marianna Móré, followed by an early session of accredited papers and 5 further sessions. During the day, 46 papers were presented by 57 authors. The programme was enriched by the facial exercise training of Andrea Sebestyén and the training of the Nyíregyháza Senior Joy Dancers.

The English language day of the Conference was organised in English by the Faculty of Health Sciences in collaboration with the Department of Gerontology Faculty for Social Wellbeing University of Malta, in an online format. The plenary lectures were given by Agota Kun on positive ageing and Christian Borg Xuereb on dementia. Also on this day, participants worked in 5 sessions. 40 presentations were given from 15 countries.

On 10-11 October, the Faculty of Health Sciences 2024 will welcome speakers and interested visitors to the Gerontology Days 2024 Conference.

HOMeAge project EU Horizon

Ireland Dr. Katalin Papp

Katalin Papp, currently a lecturer in the Department of Gerontology and a retired associate professor at the Faculty of Health Sciences, has visited Ireland.

The Advancing Research and Training on Ageing, Place and Home - HOMeAGE project is part of a winning Horizon Europe project involving institutions from 13 countries.

The programme is part of the implementation of the HomeAge application. It aims to map home conditions for older people in several European countries. This involved, among others, active older people from the member countries and 12 PhD students as young researchers and their mentors.

The second meeting of the 2-year project was held in person at the University of Galway, Ireland, 17-20 October 2023. The Hungarian member of the Reference Group is Katalin Papp Dr., lecturer at DE ETK.

In addition to the presentations by the Reference Group members, the young researchers also presented the aims and methods of their chosen research topic. It is a great pride for DE ETK that the MSc in Health Social Work student Roaa Shaaban from Syria, who graduated in June 2023 and is now pursuing her doctoral studies at the University of Frankfurt, was also selected as one of the project implementers.

Katalin Papp is also member of the Editorial Board of the Hungarian Gerontology Journal and AGE Hungary, the MESZK (Hungarian Chamber of Health Care Professionals)- Secretary for External Relations and founding member of the European Transcultural Nursing Association, ETNA.
